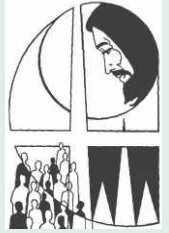

MASS INTENTIONS FOR NEW YEAR:

Reading the Church Bulletin, you may have noticed that in the past few weeks we had very few special Mass Intentions requested. You are welcome to contact the Parish Office (435-6811) to request that your special intentions are included in our 'Mass Intention Book'. A reminder: Each time we gather for the liturgical celebration of a Mass, we are called to nourish the 4 general intentions: Adoration, Thanksgiving, Contrition and Petition. In addition to these general intentions, we are invited to add various **special intentions** as well. The Church has had a tradition of adding special intentions to pray for both the deceased and the living. Parishioners and families **often request such special intentions for each Mass** --on either weekends or weekdays (even when you cannot physically be at Mass). The financial offerings or 'stipends' given are considered a support to the church and belong to the Parish.

Dear Parishioners and Friends of St. Matthew's:

Over a week ago Bishop Ricken sent a special letter to us as well as to all other Catholics in our Green Bay Diocese to inform us that very recently the U. S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) issued an unprecedented ruling which confirmed that virtually all private health plans will be required to include coverage for sterilizations and contraceptives, including abortion-inducing drugs. In spite of many appeals, the Administration also refused to broaden the religious exemption in these rules --an exemption limited to groups that hire and serve people primarily of their own faith. In other words, most churches and church-run institutions do not qualify because of their very openness in serving the common good of society and all people regardless of creed.



In the letter Bishop wrote: "In so ruling, the Administration has cast aside the First Amendment to the Constitution of the United States, denying to Catholics our nation's first and most fundamental freedom, that of religious liberty. This blatant disregard for our religious values is difficult to reconcile with the Administration's earlier assurance that they would provide for 'robust' conscience protection for religious groups in health care reform. And as a result, unless the rule is overturned, we Catholics will be compelled either to violate our consciences, or to drop health coverage for our employees (and suffer the penalties for doing so). The Administration's sole concession was to give our institutions one year to comply. We cannot -we will not- comply with this unjust law." Toward the end of the Letter, Bishop wrote: "And therefore, I would ask of you two things. First, as a community of faith we must commit ourselves to prayer and fasting that wisdom and justice may prevail, and religious liberty may be restored. Without God, we can do nothing; with God, nothing is impossible. Second, I would also recommend visiting www.usccb.org/conscience to learn more about this severe assault on religious liberty, and how to contact Congress in support of legislation that would reverse the Administration's decision."
